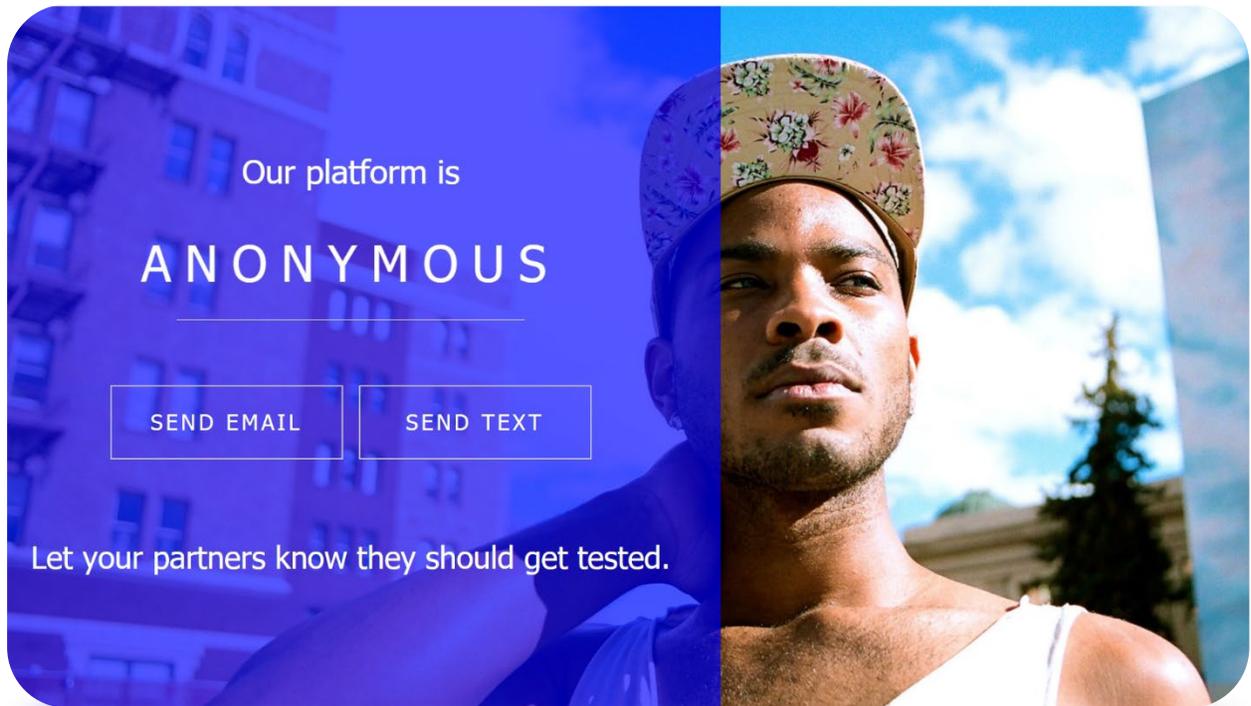


So You're Positive, Now What?

It can be hard to inform partners that they might have been exposed to an STI. We also know it feels better knowing that we're taking care of our partners' health. We believe that the more ways we have of telling our partners, the better off we'll all be.

You might feel awkward, scared, and worried about your partner's reaction. Your local health department can help and will protect your anonymity too. Having a way to tell them anonymously gives you options.

You can help stop the spread.

The Atlantic County Division of Public Health offers confidential STD testing, treatment, counseling/education, HIV testing and PrEP referrals at no cost to county residents. The walk-in clinic is open every Monday (except holidays) 2:00-4:00PM at 201 S. Shore Road in Northfield.

This is an important message about your health. One of your sexual partners recently tested positive for (disease) and is notifying you through an anonymous notification service. (They left you this message: "if you left a message it would go here)". We recommend getting tested even if you are not experiencing any symptoms. Please do not reply to this text.
