Immunizations for Adults 19 Years of Age and Older

The Atlantic County Division of Public Health provides the following vaccinations for adults 19 years of age and older at no charge for New Jersey residents without insurance or those whose insurance does not cover these vaccines:

- Influenza (Flu)
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- HPV (Human Papillomavirus)
- MMR (Measles-Mumps-Rubella)
- Meningococcal
- Pneumococcal (PPSV23 and PCV13)
- Tdap (Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- Zoster (Shingles)

Vaccines During Pregnancy

- Influenza vaccine should be given for each pregnancy during the influenza season.
- Tdap dose should be given for each pregnancy, ideally between 27 and 36 weeks.
