Atlantic County Prenatal Care

Prenatal care is the health care you receive while you are pregnant. It's recommended that you start prenatal care within the first three months of your pregnancy to improve your chances of having a healthy baby. Prenatal care includes multiple screening tests, education on a healthy lifestyle, and treatment of conditions that may affect your pregnancy such as



high blood pressure or diabetes. Don't hesitate to speak up and ask the members of your healthcare team your questions during and after your pregnancy!

If you are pregnant and without health insurance, you may be eligible for Presumptive Eligibility (PE). This means you can receive temporary health insurance during your pregnancy and up until 60 days after your pregnancy is over. Are you a woman that already delivered a baby before 37-weeks? If so, let your doctor know as you may be eligible for a medication called 17P-Alphahydroxyprogesterone (17P). 17P helps stop your baby from coming too soon.
